

# **Booster Club Minutes August 1, 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00. Ten members were present.

Mark has the new menu for Kingston and it has been approved for Kingston. The new price sheets for all stands as well as the indoor stand are ready for everyone. Copies of the Kingston schedule are available tonight if you need one. We are still managing the stands at Kingston even though there still is no signed contract, and probably won't be this year.

The district has asked us if we would like a chest freezer that they no longer want. As long as it runs and costs nothing, we'll take it! It will go in lower Kingston. The popcorn crews for the fall are all set...the Runyan family will pop again this year and for Thursday events, Rob Martin and his students will bag and for Friday events, Jeanette Kellerman and the ladies will bag again. Mark and Mike will get the popcorn, nacho chips and other items from Sam's to stock up for the season. The football scrimmage will be August 18. Stand 1 will be open for that event which starts at 5 with the freshmen team and around 7 for the varsity team. The booster club will feed the teams on the night of the scrimmage as well as donate hamburgers and hot dogs for the kids' meal put on by the Football parents.

A question was asked about taking product from lower Kingston if needed. That is perfectly fine...that's what it's there for. If anyone needs t-shirts and/or sweatshirts for stand workers, they are available, so you can contact Mark if you need any. We received an email from Arlene Houk from the band parents asking if the booster club would be interested/willing to feed the Iowa State band for the "Indoor" Marching Band event on October 10<sup>th</sup>. With the budget they have to spend for that, we cannot do much, so it was decided to not do that. The concession stands will be open for that event, so we really cannot do both.

The next booster club meeting will be September 12, at 7:00.

Mike Kadlec motioned to adjourn. Rick Pike seconded. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:00.
