

**Booster Club
Minutes
January 10, 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 6:03. Nine members were present. Cyndy Hilby read the minutes. Sue Hennick motioned to accept the minutes with one clerical correction. Bob Hackney seconded. Motion carried.

Bob Hackney shared the treasurer's report. We're all paid up on our debts including the Kinston rent, leaving us with a balance of \$69,352. The cheerleaders will also sponsor a half court shooting contest with a prize of a year's worth of chips and queso. Contributions from the Booster Club help fund Performance Therapies which is an after school strength and conditioning program. We had record attendance in the winter term.

The J-Hawk jam was very busy. We took in about \$1,400 on Saturday. Sunday was also a very busy day.

Mark Fiala reported that the Hall of Fame committee has met and has 4 individual inductees. There will be no businesses this year. Inductees are Jim Cox, former teacher and coach; Mike Humphrey, concession stand volunteer for many years; Connie Aldrich, wrestling concessions since her son was here and has worked football concessions; Sue Hennick and her family who have been responsible for stand 3 for many years and more recently stand 2 as well as track and soccer. Mark has blankets and will get them to Pam Towe for the embroidery work. Mr. Kibby will work with Mark to get the write-ups done. Jackie will send the letters.

Mark Fiala thanked Mark Van Buren for bringing appetizers from Applebees which were enjoyed by the members in attendance.

Bob Hackney motioned to adjourn. Sue Hennick seconded. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 6:50.
