

**Thomas Jefferson High School Athletic Booster Club
Meeting Minutes – August 6, 2012**

President Mark Fiala called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm with 10 members and Athletic Director Chris Deam present. Sue Hennick moved the minutes of the May meeting be approved. Rick Pike seconded and the motion carried.

- The Runyan family has confirmed they will continue popping corn for the Fall season. Rob Martin and students will bag the corn for Thursday events, and Jeanette Kellerman and her team of ladies will bag for Friday events:
 - Thirty-six (36) 50# bags for all-Metro area games; thirty (30) for games featuring out-of-town opponents
 - Stand managers were reminded *not* to leave the last bag at Lower Kingston.
- Discussed what will be purchased from Sam's Club for the concession stands: list includes popcorn, nacho chips, fruit snacks, sliced cheese. Reminder to managers to have their lists ready for Marc VanBuren to pick up on Sunday afternoons.

- Stand 1 will be open during the football scrimmage Friday, August 17th at Kingston. Hot dogs and hamburgers will be given away to players as well as band members if the band is participating.
- No Benchwarmers raffle will be held this year due to timing related to AD change.
- Hills Bank asked if they could do a popcorn giveaway as they have in the past. There was no opposition.

Mark asked whether the Booster Club would be interested in looking into renaming the softball field for celebrated Jefferson coach and leader Larry Niemeyer. Mike Kadlec motioned that this effort be pursued; Rick Pike seconded, and the motion carried.
