

## Thomas Jefferson High School Athletic Booster Club

### Meeting Minutes - February 6, 2012

Mike Kadlec, Vice-President, called the meeting to order at 7:00 with 8 members and 2 coaches present.

In Secretary Deb Winter's absence, Sally Robinson read minutes from the January meeting. Bob Hackney motioned to accept the minutes as read and Erin Seely seconded. Motion carried.

In presenting the Treasurer's report, Bob Hackney noted that the total expense for the Benchwarmer Raffle includes sales tax from last year's raffle that was paid this year. Scott Kibby added that the cost of printing the tickets has not yet been billed. That will bring the net profit to around \$4000. Bob also said that another \$20,000 donation will bring the fiscal year total to \$100,000. A motion will be presented at the March meeting. Marc Van Buren motioned to accept the Treasurer's report; Erin Seely seconded. Motion carried.

Bill Calloway, women's track coach, reported that track practice will begin next Monday, February 13. He is positive about this year's season and anticipates about 50 girls, including the full State championship 4x200 relay team. Both Bill and men's coach Ron Tower praised the benefits of the Performance Physical Education program and thanked all those involved, as well as the Booster Club for its continued support. Ron is also excited for the upcoming season and reported that the kids are anxious to get started. He expects 80-90 boys.

Scott reported that Performance P.E. is currently offered during early bird and 7<sup>th</sup> periods, and will be offered 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> periods during Fall term.

Jefferson will play sub-state basketball games at home this year. Girls will play Marshalltown at 7pm Wednesday, February 15. Boys will play the winner of the Marshalltown - Mason City game at 7pm Friday, February 24. Mike read correspondence from a DJ in Marshalltown who is excited to be coming to Jefferson because of "the best concession stand in the State." ☺

Mike reported that the freezer in the indoor stand was not working. He had called for service. (Update: on Tuesday the refrigerator was not cooling at all and the serviceman said there was a leak in the seal. Mike did not feel comfortable ordering repair without Mark's input.)

Golf Outing is scheduled for 9am Sunday, May 6, at Wildcat in Shellsburg. Erin Seely e-mailed the "save the date" notice to Mark Fiala for approval before distribution. The only change from years past is \$5 increase in the cost, which she doubts will deter potential participants.

Bob Hackney motioned to send Larry McKinnon \$100 for photographing the Hall of Fame night. Scott Kibby seconded. Motion carried.

Mike mentioned the Farner-Bocken product show in Des Moines but did not have the date.

The concession stand will not be open during the March 11 Flying "J" volleyball event, as not enough teams are participating to ensure a good crowd. The February 19 event also cancelled. Scott Kibby noted that since Jim Womochil, who has been the DECA sponsor, is on leave, he has no information about the 3 point/slam dunk contest that had been scheduled for Friday, March 16.

Applebee's Wings Night is this Friday, February 10. Proceeds from the sale of wings will benefit the Booster Club. Cheerleaders will raffle two chances to attempt a half-court shot during halftime of the boys' game. Making the shot wins a free meal at Applebee's each month for a year.

Upcoming events: Special Olympics basketball 9am-4pm Saturday, February 18 and Girls youth basketball tournament Saturday and Sunday, March 3-4. The next Booster Club meeting is Monday, March 5, at 7pm.

Bob Hackney motioned to adjourn the meeting and Marc Van Buren seconded. Adjournment 7:32 pm.
