### **Athletic Booster Club**

#### **Meeting Minutes – January 7, 2013**

President Mark Fiala called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with 9 members present.

Mike Kadlec motioned the minutes of the December meeting be approved, Sue Hennick seconded and the motion carried.

Bob Hackney presented the Treasurer's report. The final volleyball deposit was made...this year volleyball concessions were up from last year. Mike Kadlec motioned the treasurer's report be approved, and Rick Pike seconded. Motion carried.

There were no coaches available for tonight's meeting.

Chris Deam said that it has been a very busy couple of weeks! There is the Wrestling Invitational this Saturday and Sunday is the Bad Boys Wrestling tournament. The Crystal J-Hawk award will be presented to Rick and Jane Pike on Saturday, right before the last match. There has been some talk about getting a new baseball scoreboard. The Kernels are selling one of their scoreboards, so Chris is going to contact them to see what all if involved and get more details.

The Youth Girls basketball tournament is the first weekend in March, and that is looking like it will be 12 hour days both Saturday and Sunday.

The concessions for the J-Hawk Jam, \$2805, were down from last year (about \$3500), but that is to be expected since there were not as many teams participating this year. December's volunteer hours, for "only" 12 days that month were 324. These were reported to the school volunteer coordinator.

The formal Booster club donation presentation to the school will be at the Men's basketball game on February 12<sup>th</sup>. This has put the club's donation back to Jefferson over the \$2 million mark. Mark will be contacting people to help with the plans to make this a special event, because it is a big deal for our school.

The Hall of Fame recipient this year is David Dyrland. Mark will take care of ordering the award and the letter will be sent out from the Activities office. Hall of Fame night is February 8<sup>th</sup>.

The booster club's donation to the Jefferson Athletic Fund will surpass the \$2,000,000 mark. A committee was appointed to plan the presentation which is scheduled for February 12<sup>th</sup>. The t-shirts will be redone somehow making the 2,000,000 stand out. That is quite an accomplishment.

The contract for Kingston stadium concessions for the next two years—August 2013-August 2015) has been received. Mark and Deb need to sign it and it can then be sent back. The terms

are the same as they have been before...the stands WILL be open for all varsity events and all sophomore/varsity football games.

Applebee's Wing Night is Tuesday, February 12<sup>th</sup>.

Erin Seely has proposed Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup> for the 2013 Golf Outing. There are no baseball or softball varsity home events for that weekend, so it should work out well.

Mark received a request from the Choir parents for use of the indoor concession stand for the Invitational on March 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. The Band parents have requested a donation for the 2013 Band Carnival. No specifics were requested yet, but we can probably do what we have done in years past for both events. Bob Hackney motioned these requests be approved, Mike Kadlec seconded. The motion carried.

Tim Collins, the DECA (Business) teacher has been working with the new manager at Chick-Fil-A for his Marketing class. They have worked up a deal where we would get chicken sandwiches to sell in the concession stand. There will be no cost to us, and we can have them whenever we want them, and sell them for probably \$3, pure profit. We will try it and see how it is received.

There are several upcoming events, including the winter semi-formal dance. We will open a concession stand right outside the gym for that event. The Special Olympics basketball tournament is Saturday, February 16<sup>th</sup>. That is a fun event, but a busy one!

The next Booster club meeting is Monday, February 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00.

Meeting adjourned at 7:25 pm, motioned by Bob Hackney and seconded by Mike Kadlec.
