Concession Stand

Hours reported for December were 343 hours, with 15 events.

Recently a few items have disappeared from the indoor stand. The value is less than \$20. There is the possibility of installing a security camera and wiring it into the existing software at a cost of \$650. This will be investigated.

The sales for the J-Hawk Jam were up this year with less teams. The total sales were \$4015. Coach Horman did a great job of including details in his email that outside food was not allowed and Jefferson would have a concession stand available.

Mark suggested adding a column to the sign-up sheet that would be for the 'Assigned' teams. This field will not be populated for every event.

Mike Kadlec will be limiting his involvement with the concession stand in the 2015-2016 school year. We really need to get some more volunteers and especially stand managers.
