Marc VanBuren went over all the concession stand pricing and suggested we raise the price of the hamburgers. As a group we all discussed items that are not big sellers on the menu and if we should drop these items for the coming year.

Jim Miller made a motion to raise the hamburger price to \$3.00 and leave the Cheeseburgers at \$3.00 and drop the BBQ Beef, Baby Ruth, Starbust, Twizzlers, Sour Skittles and Red & Green Sour Punch Candy Straws. Marc VanBuren seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

Mark Fiala will be sending Greta McChesney the electronic files of the concession stand price sheets so she can update them and make the necessary copies.

Pricing meeting ended and Jim Miller called to order the regular Booster Club meeting at 7:00pm

### **Concession Stand:**

Softball stand has taken in around \$22,618 so far this year. Softball had 6 ½ dates that were complete rainouts so this hurt the numbers this year.

Baseball concession is still using the popcorn popper from stand 2. Their kettle is still at Star and they said they found nothing wrong with the kettle/motor and it worked for them. Rick Pike and Jim will pick up the kettle and put it back in the popper to see if it works.

Karman and Steve are finishing up their last summer as baseball concession stand manager and we are still looking for someone to replace them for next season.

New Position Concession Coordinator, was created to oversee all the concession stands. Sue Hennick agreed to take this position.

Jim Miller and Laura Hard agreed to run Stand 1 together this next year. Mark Fiala agreed to still help with starting things up in Stand 1 until Jim and Laura can get there.

Drum Corp competition is July 27<sup>th</sup>. Gates open at 5:00pm and should be finished around 9:30pm. Stand 1 & 2 will be open. Drinks need to be filled and popcorn poppers need to be organized for this event. Sue Hennick will get this taken care of.

Jane Pike will be the Volleyball concession stand manager this fall.

We are still looking for managers for Wrestling, Men's and Women's basketball.

### **Old Business:**

Booster Club is still looking into creating and filling a Volunteer Coordinator position.

Jim Miller is finalizing the Kingston Contract.

The Crystal J-Hawk award for Fran Northern will be presented to her family during one of the football games this fall.

### **New Business:**

Booster Club Membership prices have changed for this coming school year. The \$10.00 membership has been dropped and now the lowest membership is \$25.00. The White level is \$100.00 and the Blue Level is \$200.00 and you can add a Grandparent to the Blue membership for \$10.00 per person.

Booster Club Meetings dates have changed and now will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of the month starting at 7:00pm. These meetings will be located in the IMC upstairs.

The Bylaws will need to be corrected with this new meeting time. The Bylaws are not in any kind of electronic format. Mark Fiala will give a copy of the bylaws to Greta McChesney to correct and put into a word document.

Greta said she will email Chris Deam to find out if the softball gates could be added to the staff volunteer sign ups.
