

# **Booster Club Minutes October 7, 2013**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00, seven members were present.

## **Minutes**

Mr. Deam reviewed the Annual Financial Report for the Activities Office. All agreed it looked good, a few questions, but once explained, no concerns.

## **Concession Stand**

Hours reported for September was 1651.5 hours. This was for the indoor stand, Kingston events, the homecoming dance and the popcorn popping and bagging.

The homecoming dance on September 21 generated \$753, not as good as previous years, but still a nice profit for the time frame.

The Five Season's Marching Band competition on October 5 had a deposit of \$9694. As in the past, this is the biggest one day fundraiser. This is the case every year.

A discussion was had on suggestions for alternate ways to fill the slots at the concession stands.

To date, there are 30 events completed at Kingston with 11 remaining. A playoff game is not anticipated at this time due to the records of the metro schools. Volleyball concessions are slightly behind last year's YTD.

### **Old Business**

The concession stands will be dropping the smoothies from the menu. After talking with Frozen Beverage, we've decided to part ways.

We again had an entry in the homecoming parade. Dick and Mark drove the gator while Lisa and Marc handed out candy.

Mark has heard back from Mary Crane regarding the Heinz products for Jefferson concession stands. There will be no more donations this year and Heinz will let us know if they decide to continue the corporate donations. There may not be enough product left to finish Kingston, that is to be determined. This includes the taco meat and chili.

We are still looking for folks interested in being officers for the 2014-2015 school year. Now is the perfect time so they can shadow the existing officers. Mike Kadlec stated he will likely NOT run next year so this slot needs to be filled.

### **New Business**

Discussion was had on when/how much to donate to the JHawk Athletic Program. Due to the Kingston donation from last spring, the donation to the district for this fall's football program, plus the October Dr. Pepper bill, which is expected to be approximately \$14,000, the suggestion was made to table this until the November meeting. All agreed.

The Indoor Stand will have several dates to cover including 29 Men's BB, 25 Women's BB, 6 Wrestling, and 4 Men's Swimming. The stand managers have been assigned for Men's BB-Mike and Mark, Women's BB-Edna and Laura and Wrestling-Rick Pike and Jim Miller. Due to some possible overlap and the timeframes for the events, Jim Miller has tentatively agreed to also manage the Men's Swimming events.
