Concession Stand

Hours reported for August were 504 hours, with 5 events. We currently have two people working three hours each week making the popcorn and another ten people working four hours each week to bag the popcorn. On August 29th we had 30 volunteers for 75 hours.

Jim will create signs to be posted at stand three and four, depending on which one is closed for certain games. The signs will direct visitors to the other stand.

Mark has shirts from 2012 and sweatshirts from 2013 for any concession stand worker that is interested. Please send him the names.

There used to be a ceiling fan in the indoor concession booth. This fan was removed during construction. There are two free ceiling fans available from the library if approval can be granted for installation. Chris will follow up on this item.

Old Business

Mark and Mike will staff a table at the open house. Any individual that signs up tonight to work in the concession stand will receive a t-shirt.

New Business

The Firebowl fundraiser will be held at Kingston on September 14 from 8:00am-2:00pm. The sponsors for this event will be providing food, but we have been invited to open the concession stand if we'd like. Mark was going to check with his contact to see if the sponsors would also be providing drinks and snacks. If so, we will not open, if not, we can open one stand for a bit to sell these items.

It is very important for all stand managers to let Mark know if the folks that signed up to work a concession slot via the My Signup link actually show up to work their shift. Likewise, please let Mark know if others show up, but didn't sign up.

We briefly reviewed the State Farm policy endorsements.

The ISU band will be at Kingston on Friday, September 12 for the Washington game. It's unclear if they are playing between the games or at halftime of the varsity game. They are bringing in their own meal and will be sitting in the bleachers by stand three.

An indoor stand manager is needed for the Women's and Men's basketball season. Please see Mark if interested/available in this position.

Jim Miller is going to head up a committee to explore increased participation in both our meetings and the concession stands. Chris Deam, Lisa Stodola, and Deb Winter have agreed to assist.

One of the old freezers died and there were two boxes of chili that were spoiled. A new 15 cu chest freezer was purchased for \$399.

The booster club will again have an entry in the Jefferson Homecoming parade on Friday October 10. We will hand out candy and drive the gator as in the past.

We will once again sell concessions at the Homecoming dance on October 11.

It is possible there will also be a softball event on October 4, during one of the band events. If so, we will need a stand manager/assistant at stand one.

As always, we are looking for any individuals interested in a possible officer position for the 2015-2016 school year. Ideally, we'd like the individuals to begin job shadowing now so they are prepared for next year.

Mark sent an email regarding a change in padlocks and looking for any stray keys. If you have a key with the number 2643 on it, please turn that key into Mark as the padlocks that key works with have all been replaced.
